Special Instructions:

- Do not use acronyms or abbreviations in the “Technical Data or Computer Software to be Furnished with Restrictions” column
 - Spell out all words and acronyms even if used more than once
- Do not use references such as “All data related to...” or “All data pertaining to...”
 - List out all data items by name, number, and data element type
- Do not use slashes (/) in assertions
 - These are understood to mean “and” by the USG so if this is not the case it needs to be specified. If that is the case, use “and” instead of “/” to eliminate any confusion or misinterpretation
- Do not assert rights against items listed under DFARS 252.227-7013(b)(1)(i-ix)
